# RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ROSS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO SUPPORT A RURAL INDUSTRIAL PARK LOAN PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR THE BENEFIT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The Board of Commissioners of the County of Ross, Ohio, met in regular session on March 11, 2024 to adopt the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, Ross County, Ohio, is supportive of the development and submission of a Rural Industrial Park Loan Program application, in accordance with Section 122.24 of the Ohio Revised Code, to promote economic development in eligible rural areas and promote the economic welfare of Ross County and the State of Ohio.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Ross County, Ohio, that:

**Section1**: The Board acknowledges the project site, Parcel 140109269000, is located at 5495 SR 159 which is located in Ross County, Ohio, and that Ross County, Ohio, has been identified as an eligible county in accordance with Program guidelines.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Board acknowledges that no existing industrial park located in the county would compete against the industrial park that would be developed and improved through the use of financial assistance provided to the applicant under the Rural Industrial Park Loan Program.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Board recognizes the applicant for the Rural Industrial Park Loan Program assistance to be Buckeye Land Holdings, LLC, is an eligible applicant in accordance with the Program guidelines.

**Section 4**: The Board recognizes the applicant has the capacity to undertake and successfully oversee the project.

<u>Section 5:</u> The board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of the Board that resulted in those formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 6: This Resolutions shall be in force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.

# AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM GRANT A WARDS - STANDARD ALLOWANCE FUND TO THE 104 SEWER PROJECT 650-01

The following resolution was passed at the regular meeting of the Ross County Board of Commissioners, March 4, 2024, with Dwight A. Garrett, James E. Lowe, and Jack A. Everson in attendance.

WHEREAS, in response to the economic fallout caused by the COVID19 pandemic, Ross County had previously received American Rescue Plan Act funds (ARP A) for 2021/2022, and said funds were distributed to local entities to provide relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all options from the January 6, 2022, publication from the U.S. Treasury regarding the Final Rule for the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF), which took effect on April 1, 2022, this Board had made a determination to move forward by taking advantage of its flexibilities and simplifications at that time; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ross County Commissioners has previously adopted the U.S. Treasury's Final Rule and choose the Standard Allowance for revenue loss up to \$10 million for ARPA funds pursuant to Resolution 015-22, adopted on April 25, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Ross County Commissioners, upon the adoption of Resolution 015-22, caused \$10 million in SLFRF monies to be set aside for such revenue loss in the Grant Awards - Standard Allowance fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ross County Board of Commissioners has determined that it is necessary to use the balance of that \$10 million revenue loss allocation for the specific purpose of funding the State Route 104 Sewer Project, said balance being \$9,601,417.26 million; and

WHEREAS, O.R.C. 5705.15 provides for the transfer of funds from one fund to another, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the Ross County Board of Commissioners, that the Ross County Auditor be and is hereby authorized to transfer the \$9,601,417.26 million balance currently located in the Grant Awards - Standard Allowance fund, to the general fund; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that said \$9,601,417.26 million is being transferred to the 104 Sewer Project fund 650-01, for the specific purpose of being used for the State Route 104 Sewer Project.

On call of the roll, the vote was: Mr. Everson, yes; Mr. Lowe, yes; Mr. Garrett, yes. Motion carried.

### **RESOLUTION 011-24 RESENDED**

### T HANGAR VIOLATION LETTER ROSS COUNTY SHOEMAKER AIRPORT
