#### RESOLUTION 019-24 OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) SALT PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, the Board, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5513.01 (B), may participate in the contracts entered into by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for supplies and materials; and

WHEREAS, ODOT has invited the Board to participate in its winter (018-25) salt contract in order to purchase rock salt; and

WHEREAS, that the Ross County Board of Commissioners hereby enters into the ODOT Salt Participation Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board shall execute the Agreement in the name of the Ross County Engineer as its political subdivision; now, therefore, be it **RESOLVED**, that the Ross County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes and instructs the Ross County Engineer, Charles Ortman, to complete all necessary paperwork order forms and be the contract person, for the county to participate in the ODOT Salt Participation Program. Adopted this 29th day of April, 2024.

#### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION** IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT CONTRACTS AWARDED IN 2024

**WHEREAS**, the Ross County Engineer, Ross County, Ohio (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision") hereby submits this, written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.0l(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon of award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and

b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and

c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees that each party hereto shall be responsible for liability associated with that party's own errors, actions, and failures to act.

d. The Political Subdivision's electronic order for Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) will be the amount the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and

e. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its electronically submitted salt quantities from its awarded salt

supplier during the contract's effective period; and

f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and

g. The Political Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request by no later than Friday, May 3rd, by 5:00 p.m. The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision's participation agreement and/or a Political Subdivision's request to rescind its participation agreement.

**NOW, THERFORE,** be it ordained by the following authorized person (s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation on the ODOT salt contract.

Duration of this agreement is for a period of (20) years beginning on the date of the execution hereof subject however to early termination as provided in Section Fourteen herein.

# **OTHER BUSINESS**

**Judge Benson updated** the Commissioners on the progress of the Guardianship fund set up with MRDD, JFS, ADAMH, and Probate Court. Each member has contributed \$27,625.00 to provide Guardianship services for legally incompetent individuals. The court has tentatively contracted with Kohlman Guardianship Services to provide a Social Worker to take on this responsibility. Judge Benson requested use of a vacant office space, in his court, at no cost to the program. If he is unable to find space in another facility the Commissioners will reconsider his request.

# PUBLIC HEARING CHIP 2024

**Mr. Dale Hartle President and CEO** of the Ohio Regional Development Corporation held the first Public Hearing for the PY 2024 Community Housing Improvement Program available for Ross County partnering with the City of Chillicothe, to apply for funding from the Ohio Department of Development, Office of Community Enhancements (OCE) in 2024.
