REDUCING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2026 ROSS COUNTY GENERAL FUND CURRENT EXPENSES TAX RATE MILLAGE FROM 2.4 MILLS TO 1.68 MILLS WITHIN THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION AND RESERVING A TOTAL OF 1.42 MILLS PURSUANT TO O.R.C. 5705.313

The following resolution was passed at the regular meeting of the Ross

County Board of Commissioners, September 29, 2025, with David A. Glass II, James E. Lowe, and Jack A. Everson in attendance.

WHEREAS, the Ross County Board of Commissioners has previously adopted a resolution pursuant to section 5739.021 or 5739.026 of the Revised Code to levy or increase the rate of the sales tax; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.313(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code permits the Ross County Board of Commissioners to adopt another resolution reducing the rate of any property tax the county currently is levying for current expenses within the ten-mill limitation; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.313(A)(2) further permits the Ross County Board of Commissioners to reserve the rate of reduction of any property tax for a specified period of time so that amount of millage reduced by the Ross County Board of Commissioners may not be used by another political subdivision unless permitted under the same statute; and

WHEREAS, on or about August 12, 2024, the Ross County Board of Commissioners passed Resolution 032-24 wherein they reduced the 2025 Ross County General Fund current expenses tax millage rate from 3.1 mill to 2.4 mill, and reserved the reduced 0.7 mill for future use pursuant to Section 5705.313 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Ross County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to Section 5705.313 of the Ohio Revised Code, now desires to make an additional reduction of the Ross County General Fund current expenses tax rate millage from the current millage of 2.4 mill, down to 1.68 mill for the upcoming tax year; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Ross County Board of Commissioners, that the 2.4 mill that has been levied in Ross County for the calendar year 2025, for current expenses within the ten-mill limitation, be reduced to 1.68 mill for the calendar year 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this 0.72 mill difference will not be levied against the citizens of Ross County for the calendar year 2026, and the same 0.72 mill is being reserved by the Ross County Board of Commissioners so as not to be used by another political subdivision for the calendar year 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this 0.72 mill property tax rate reduction will be for a period of one year, being calendar year 2026, and may be reconsidered by the Ross County Board of Commissioners for future years beyond calendar year 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the 0.7 mill reduction authorized by Resolution 032-24 will continue to not be levied against the citizens of Ross County for the calendar year 2026, and the Ross County Board of Commissioners will continue to reserve this 0.7 mill so as not to be used by another political subdivision for the calendar year 2026, which brings the total millage reserved by the Ross County Board of Commissioners to 1.42 mill.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Ross County Board of Commissioners that members of the Ross County Sheriff's Department did not receive proper compensation for work performed during the period of July 1 to July 12; and

WHEREAS, the unpaid period totals twelve (12) working days and was due to an error in the communication from Union Representatives regarding the first full pay of July; and

WHEREAS, the Ross County Board of Commissioners recognizes the legal and ethical obligation to ensure timely and accurate payment for services rendered;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Employees of the Ross County Sheriff's Department belonging to the Teamsters Local 284 Blue and Gold unit, shall be compensated for twelve (12) days of back pay covering the period from July 1 to July 12.
- 2. The Finance/Payroll Department is hereby authorized and directed to process and release the back pay in the next payroll cycle or as soon as administratively possible.
- 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval.

Jody Walker, Executive Director at South Central Ohio Job and Family Services – Discussed how Federal Legislation (H.R.1) will change SNAP Program finances

Julie Bolen, Executive Director Community Action – provided an update on the Ross County Community Resource Center and the implementation of a Homelessness Taskforce Committee.

Ohio Erie Development Company – Franklin Conaway, Dwight McCabe and David Poe, the McCabe Companies – presented their plan for design and funding for the Old Canal building on the corner of Main Street and Mulberry St. They are asking for a letter of support from the County Commissioners and to allow the Port Authority to search for grants to make up for a one million dollar short fall for the project.

Vandermark Lane Vacation – County Engineer Charlie Ortman and County Prosecutor Jeff Marks discussed the request from the Scioto Township Trustees to vacate the farthest most section of Vandermark Road located adjacent to Auditor Parcel Number 26-1609003.000. Mr. Ortman will find out if Scioto Township is still collecting auto registration distribution funds on Vandermark Road. This plays a role in whether the road can legally be vacated. Once this information is collected the parties will reconvene.
