WHEREAS, the ROSS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS seeks to construct the VILLAGE OF CLARSKBURG; THIRD STREET RECONSTRUCTION Project; and

WHEREAS, the ROSS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS has intent to use Community Development Block Grant funding for the Project.
