WHEREAS, The amount of money to be reserved in the fund in any fiscal year shall not exceed five percent (5%) of the revenue credited in the preceding year to the general fund, and

WHEREAS, Subject to Ohio Revised Code 5705.29, division (G), any reserve balance in an account established under division (A)(1) of Ohio Revised Code 5705.13 shall not be considered part of the unencumbered balance or revenue, and

WHEREAS, The Ross County Board of Commissioners request the Ross County Auditor to establish a non-general fund to stabilize the general fund in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5705.13 (A)(1).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ross County Board of Commissioners hereby authorize the Ross County Auditor to create a non-general fund to stabilize the general fund against cyclical changes in revenue and expenditures in accordance of Ohio Revised Code 5705.13 (A)(1). The reserve amount of money shall not exceed five percent (5%) of the revenue credited to the general fund in the preceding fiscal year and shall not be considered part of the unencumbered balance or revenue for the general fund.

DISABILITY AWARENESS MONTH 2024

- Recognize the barriers presented to those with disabilities.

- Understand the losses (financial, spiritual, human rights, contributions to community, and otherwise) when our communities segregate and create barriers for those with disabilities.
